

# How to Fix the Windows 11 Update Error 0x80888002

## 1. Run a couple of commands

1. Open the **Start** menu by pressing the `Win` key.
2. Open the **command prompt as an admin**.
3. Type the below command and press `Enter`.  
`reg delete "HKLM\SOFTWARE\Microsoft\Windows NT\CurrentVersion\Image File Execution Options\vdslldr."`
4. If the above command doesn't work, then you can try the below command and press `Enter`.  
`wmic /namespace:"\root\subscription" path __EventFilter where Name="Skip TPM Check on Dynamic Update"`

One user suggested this solution on the official Microsoft forum and it has helped several users fix the Windows update error 0x80888002. You can also try running either of the above two commands and check if this resolves the issue or not.

## 2. Run Windows Update troubleshooter

1. Press the `Win + I` keys to open the **Settings** menu
2. Click on **Troubleshoot**.
3. Select **Other troubleshooters**.
4. Click on the **Run** next to *Windows Update*.
5. Follow the **onscreen prompts** to begin the troubleshooting.
6. **Apply** the promoted fixes.
7. **Restart** your PC.
8. Try **downloading the Windows Update** and see if this fixes the issue or not.

Windows Update troubleshooter can help you resolve multiple issues on your PC related to Windows updates. You can try running it and see if this fixes the error 0x80888002.

## 3. Reset Windows Update components

1. Open the **Start** menu by pressing the `Win` key.
2. Run the **command prompt as an admin**.
3. Type the below commands and press `Enter` after each one.

```
net stop bitsnet stop wuauservnet stop appidsvcnet stop cryptsvcDel "%ALLUSERSPROFILE%\Application
```

4. **Restart** your PC.
